INTENT:

It is the intent of Lake County, Illinois to modernize the county's fleet management software with a more technologically robust system that will enhance reporting, create efficiencies, detailed billing, and more user friendly for creating work orders by the technicians.

SCOPE OF WORK:

- Provide a fleet maintenance software program and all necessary hardware.
- Option to provide additional real-time operational data.
- Provide in-depth training on the use of the software, creating reports and system maintenance.
- Vehicle specific master files with cradle to grave costs.
- Provide vehicle and asset work order generation.
- Have the ability to run reports such as but not limited to: technician efficiencies, vehicle usage, master lists, fuel
 reporting, vehicle downtime reports, monthly billing, annual replacement reports, and the ability to create custom
 reports upon request.
- Track vehicle costs.
- Track personnel productivity.
- Direct and indirect labor costs.
- Asset replacement trend analysis.

- Track vehicle warranties.
- Track accident costs.
- Track parts and parts inventory.
- Detailed reports shall comply with ICMA standards.
- Vehicle codes shall comply to Vehicle Maintenance Reporting Software, North American Fleet Association, and American Public Works Association standards.
- Shall support bar coding or other canning method.
- Have the ability to import existing fleet information into your system.
- Have the ability to import fuel data into the Fleet Management Software.
- A data/ table dictionary shall be made available to county IT staff.
