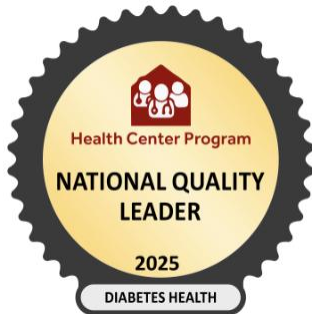

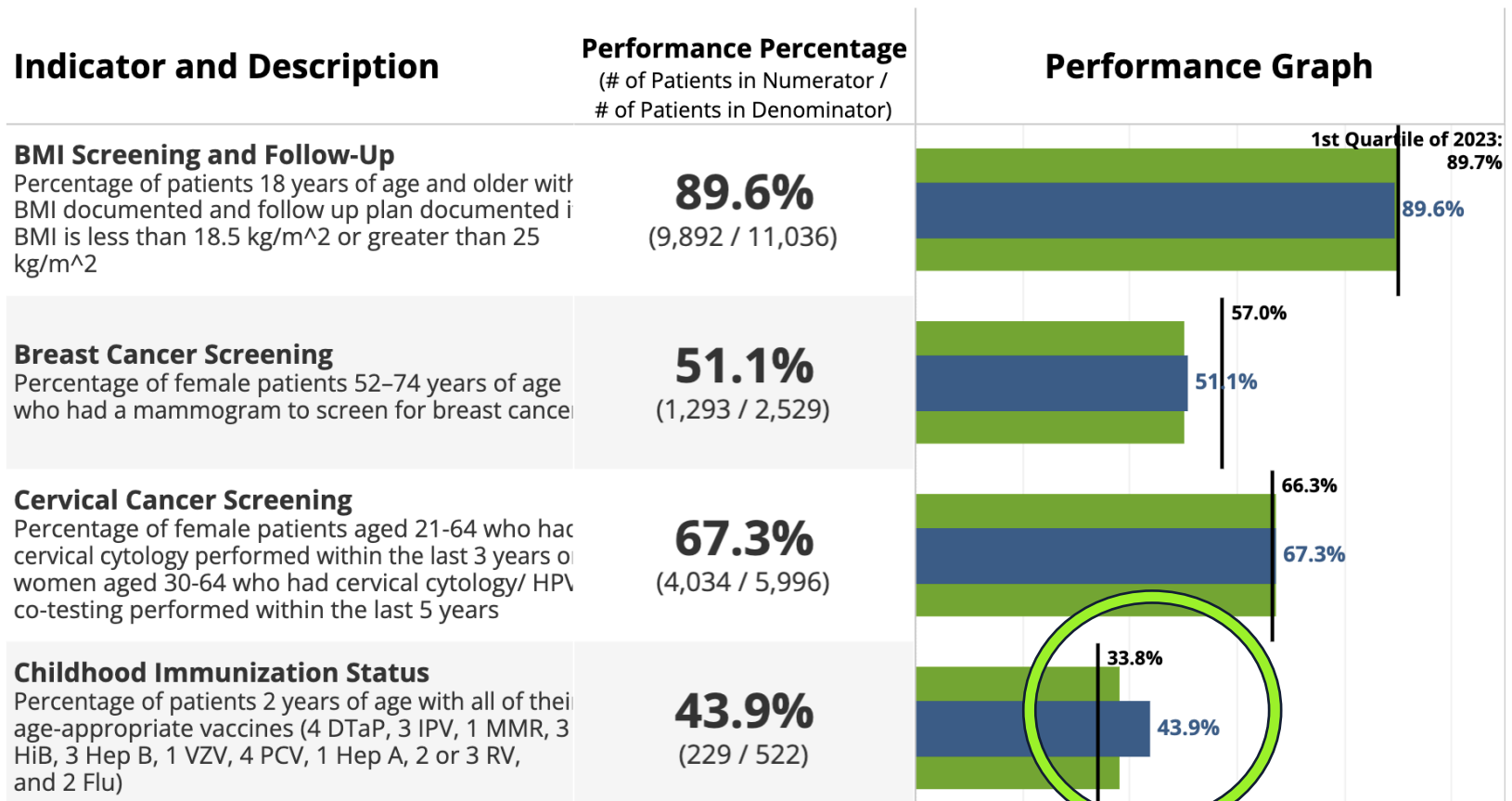


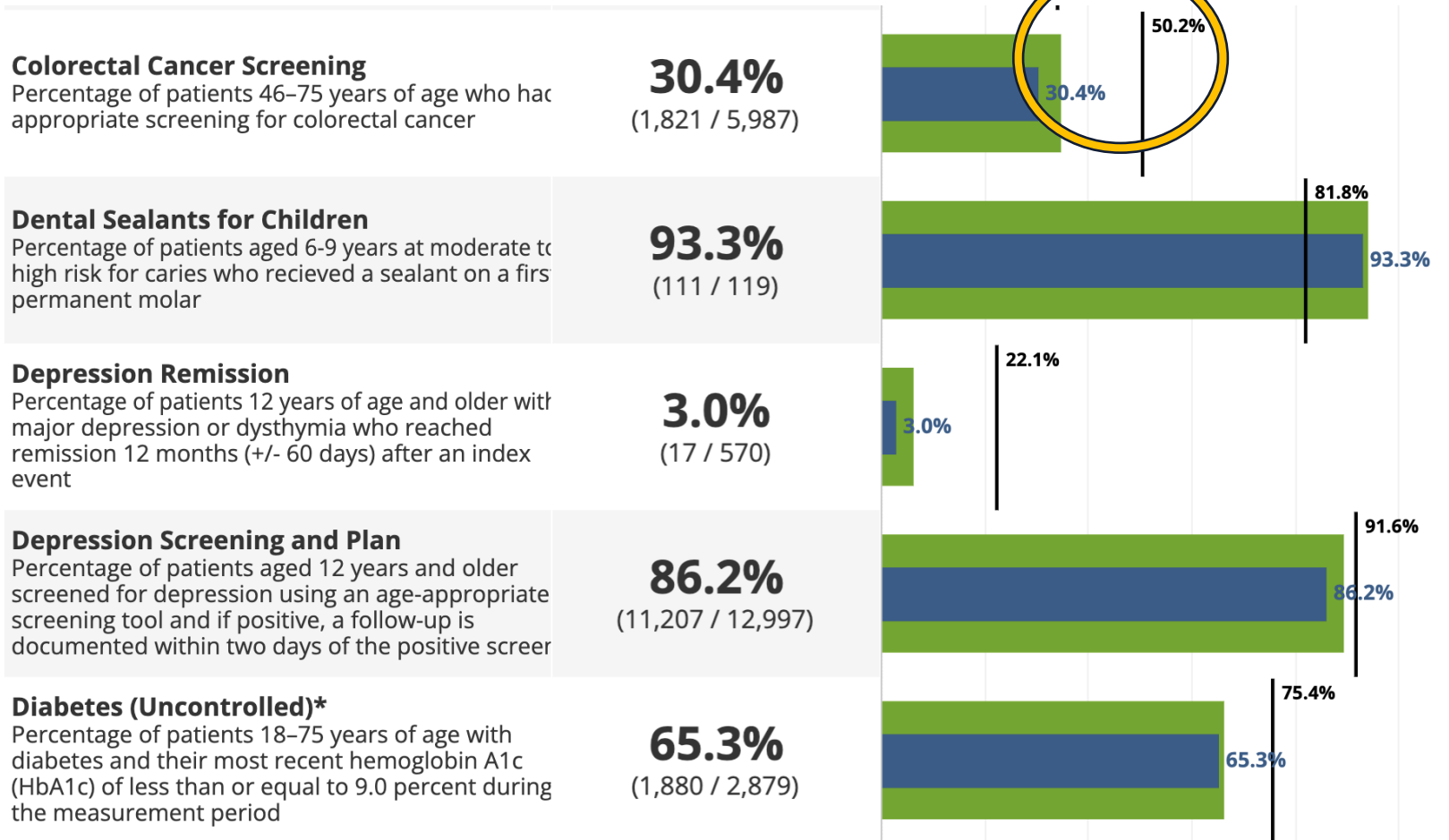
Current Projects

- Improved reporting to allow for lists of patients with future appointments.
- Staff are setting alerts for patients requiring a statin, antiplatelet, or HIV testing for teams to identify.

HIV Screening

Percentage of patients 15-65 years of age who were tested for HIV

Hypertension (Controlled)

Percentage of patients 18-85 years of age who had a diagnosis of hypertension and whose blood pressure (BP) was adequately controlled (less than 140/90 mmHg) during the measurement period

Ischemic Vascular Disease Medication Use

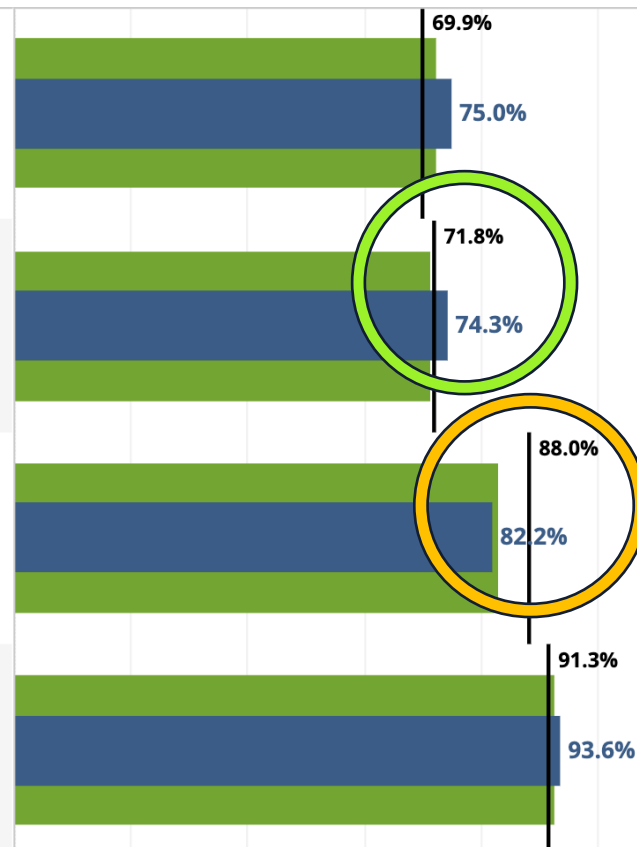
Percentage of adult patients with IVD or an acute myocardial infarction, coronary artery bypass graft, or percutaneous coronary intervention in the previous year and used aspirin or an antiplatelet

Low Birth Weights*

Percentage of babies of health center prenatal care patients born whose birth weight was normal or above normal (equal to or greater than 2,500 grams).

Percentage of prenatal patients with their first prenatal visit during their first trimester

Tobacco Screening and Cessation

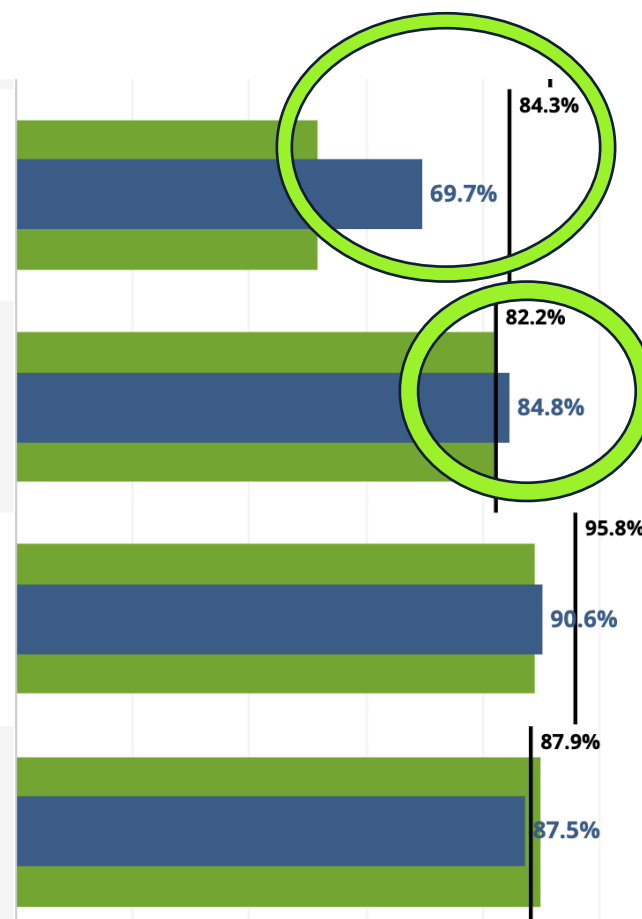
Percentage of patients aged 12 and older who were screened for tobacco use and who received cessation counseling intervention if defined as a tobacco user
