Joint resolution authorizing an emergency appropriation and execution of an agreement for a 2009 American Reinvestment and Recovery Act JAG Grant, to support a crime analyst position, in the amount of \$165,079.

- The Project Safe Neighborhoods grant previously funded a crime analyst position from May 2008 to November 2009; however, this grant expired and was not renewed.
- Through the federal ARRA grant #809053 the State's Attorney's Office would receive 100% funding to reinstate a crime analyst position from May 1, 2011 to February 28, 2013.
- The program supports 21 months of salary, fringe and administrative expenses of a Crime Analyst position for the State's Attorney's Office.
- The Crime Analyst will perform duties in the Drug Prosecution/Asset Forfeiture Division to gather, analyze and disseminate information with local, state and federal law enforcement agencies in furtherance of investigation and prosecution of organized crime members.
- The Crime Analyst position will be eliminated upon the expiration of ARRA grant #809053.
