Vote to recommend approval by Lake County Board of Memorandum of Understanding with Lake County Housing Authority

- In 2013, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) issued a
 notice stating that public housing authorities could no longer complete internal
 environmental review records. Instead, the responsible entity ---which in the case of
 Lake County Housing Authority (LCHA) is Lake County government must complete
 environmental review records (EERs) for applicable spending of HUD funds by the
 housing authority. The 2013 Notice is attached.
- The States Attorney's Office is tailoring a draft Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Community Development and the LCHA.
- A Request for Proposal to hire a consulting firm to provide environmental review records has been issued by the Lake County Purchasing Department.

6.4 <u>15-0950</u>

Vote to add HOME/CDBG requirements to four current Lake County Affordable Housing Program grants

 Several past HOME and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) projects may be deemed ineligible for funding by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD).

- Last year, Lake County repaid HUD \$271K by creating HOME-eligible projects out of previously committed Lake County Affordable Housing Program grants.
- Staff proposes to document specific 2013 and 2015 Lake County Affordable Housing Program projects as HOME- or CDBG-eligible projects in case repayment of past HOME or CDBG projects becomes necessary.
