#### 6.1 21-0452

Approval of the fifth amendment to the 2019 United States Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Annual Action Plan (AAP).

- The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) announced a third round of Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus relief funds (CDBG-CV3) through the CARES Act to Lake County in the amount of \$3,063,537.
- Applications from community partners were submitted on January 11, 2021.
- Funding recommendations were reviewed and approved by the Housing and Community Development Committee (HCDC) Advisory and Recommendation Committees (ARCs).

#### 6.2 21-0455

Approval of the Program Year 2021 (PY21) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding recommendations.

- On January 11, 2021 Community Development staff received applications for Program Year 2021 (PY21) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding.
- A total of \$2,920,395 of CDBG, \$1,702,091 HOME and \$225,934 of ESG funds were made available to applicants.
- PY21 scoring and funding recommendations have been reviewed and approved by the Housing and Community Development (HCDC) Advisory and Recommendation Committees (ARCs).

#### 6.3 21-0453

Approval of the Program Year 2021 (PY21) Lake County Affordable Housing Program (LCAHP) grant awards.

• In January 2021, Community Development staff received applications for eligible affordable housing programs and projects.

- The available affordable housing funding includes \$381,531 of Lake County Affordable Housing Program (LCAHP) Funds.
- On February 26, 2021, the Affordable Housing Advisory and Recommendation Committee (ARC) unanimously approved the funding recommendations.

## 6.4 <u>21-0454</u>

Approval of the Program Year 2021 (PY21) 2021 Video Gaming Revenue grant funding recommendations in the amount of \$713,260.

- In September 2016, the Board approved the Video Gaming Revenue (VGR) policy that
  outlined procedures for: capturing video gaming administrative, legal, and enforcement
  costs; and evaluating and possibly funding social programs, projects (excluding capital
  improvements), and/or services that benefit Lake County residents.
- Application scoring includes up to 60 points (pts) that are distributed based on the following priorities: assessment, education and outreach for gambling addiction (60 pts.); clinical gambling addiction services (45 pts.); non-clinical gambling addiction services (30 pts.); and other behavioral health services (15 pts).
- In January 2021, Community Development received applications for \$713,260 in available VGR funds.
- On March 4, 2021, the Public Services Advisory and Recommendation Committee (ARC) approved the VGR funding recommendations.
