Resolution appointing Dr. Michael Karner to fill the unexpired term of Roycealee Wood as Lake County Regional Superintendent of Schools.

- As a result of Roycealee Wood's resignation, a vacancy now exists in the Office of Lake County Regional Superintendent of Schools.
- In accordance with state statute, when a vacancy occurs in the office of regional superintendent of schools, the County Board Chair shall fill the vacancy within 60 days with the advice and consent of the County Board.
- Dr. Michael Karner's education includes a bachelor's degree in mathematics and Spanish, a master's in educational leadership, an education specialist degree in educational leadership, a doctorate in curriculum and instruction from George Williams College - Aurora University, and a superintendent endorsement from Concordia University Chicago, among a number of other accomplishments.
- Dr. Michael Karner has served in many roles during his career including coach, teacher, assistant principal, and principal.
