**Antibiotic Stewardship** 

This workbook reviews whether antibiotics were prescribed at the encounter where a patient presented with certain diagnosis. Encounters from the last 365 days are included (rolling). Encounters are excluded if they contain certain diagnosis (listed below) that justify antibiotic use.

<u>Diagnosis Included</u> (encounters with these diagnosis should not have an antibiotic associated with them):

Acute Pharyngitis: J02.9

Upper Respiratory Infection: J06.9

Influenza: J10.1

Encounter Excluded if Contains Any of these Diagnosis (encounters with these diagnosis could justify the use of an antibiotic):

Acute Sinusitis (Patients <18): J01.9, J01.91, J01.1, J01.11, J01.2, J01.21, J01.3, J01.31, J01.00, J01.01, J01.8, J01.81

Strep Throat: J02.0

## Antibiotics Considered:

amoxicillin, amoxicillin/potassium clav, ampicillin sodium/sulbactam Na, azithromycin, efadroxil, cefdinir, cefepime HCl in dextrose 5 %, cefixime, ceftriaxone sodium, CEFUROXIME AXETIL, cephalexin, CIPROFLOXACIN HCL, ciprofloxacin HCl/dexameth, ciprofloxacin/hydrocortisone, clarithromycin, dicloxacillin sodium, doxycycline hyclate, doxycycline monohydrate, erythromycin base, erythromycin base in ethanol, erythromycin ethylsuccinate, minocycline HCl, moxifloxacin HCl, ofloxacin, penicillin V potassium, sulfamethoxazole/trimethoprim, tetracycline HCl
