- Determination of Cause and Manner of Death
 - Covers entire county
 - Scene investigations, forensic examination and toxicology
- Administrative Functions
 - Certification of death on Coroner Cases
 - Cremation permits for any death that occurs in Lake County
 - Case file management and record keeping
- Family Support
 - Assist family member throughout process
 - Provide medicolegal answers to survivors




- Staffing

 - Toxicologist












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- Departmental Statistics 2021
 - 5,536 Total Deaths Reported
 - 673 required further investigation
 - 566 required further examination
- Average Coroner Case 96/yr./Deputy (7)
- Average Medical Case 694/yr./Deputy (7)
- 2020 Comparison
 - 6,159 Total Deaths Reported
 - 703 required further investigation
 - 581 required further examination

Previous 12 Months



- Address mortality issues Suicide and Overdoses
 - Collaborated with partner organizations
 - Provide transparent, timely and accurate statistical data
 - Identify and provide for needs of Families
 - Resources/Support, Grief Boxes, Missing Pieces
 - Identified new organizations to form partnerships for at risk population
- Address county expenditures as a result of the Pandemic
 - Re-evaluated Mass Fatality Management plan
 - Discontinued rental of overflow storage site
 - Entered in a no upfront cost MOU with funeral service for <u>emergency</u> storage



Previous 12 Months



- Staff
 - Completed implementation of evaluation process
 - Established goals for employees based on County Initiatives
 - Improved office accountability and transparency
 - Successfully finalized union contract negotiations
 - Implemented managerial case review procedures




- Expenditure Accountability
 - Implemented procedures to track spending and costs
 - Evaluated contracts to assure services are in line with costs – removal service

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Previous 12 Months



- Case Closure Rates
 - Implemented policy, procedures and effective supervision practices to reduce delay in closing of cases



Next 12 Months



- Community Involvement
 - Identify and collaborate additional partner organizations
 - Identify and provide increased services and resources for grieving families
 - Provide additional timely data to drive resources where needed
 - Continue to explore and implement a County Ecumenical Indigent Burial Program
- Evaluate expenditures/contracts
 - Continue to ensure Coroner contract services are fiscally responsible
 - Explore potential revenue generating lab services
 - Research grant funding for future equipment





Next 12 Months



- Continue staff development and accountability
 - Achieve 100% of staff Crisis Intervention Team trained
 - New Staff Members
 - Maintain staff accreditation through American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigators
- Increase 60-day case closure rate to minimum 80%
 - Increased to 75% in 2021 over 34% in 2020.
