



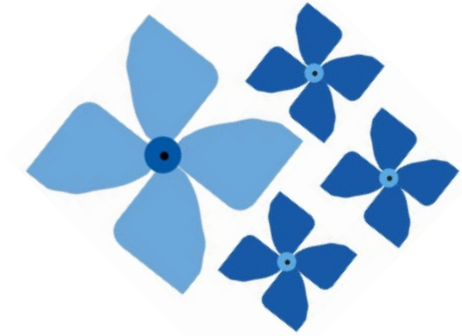
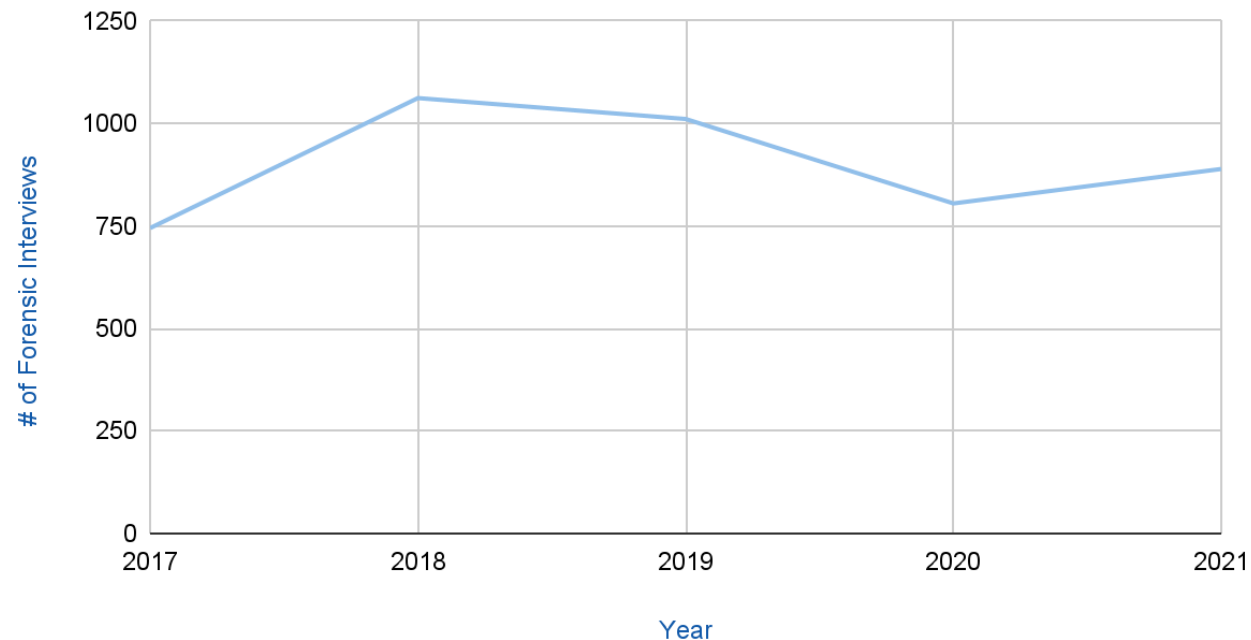

LCCAC Forensic Interviews



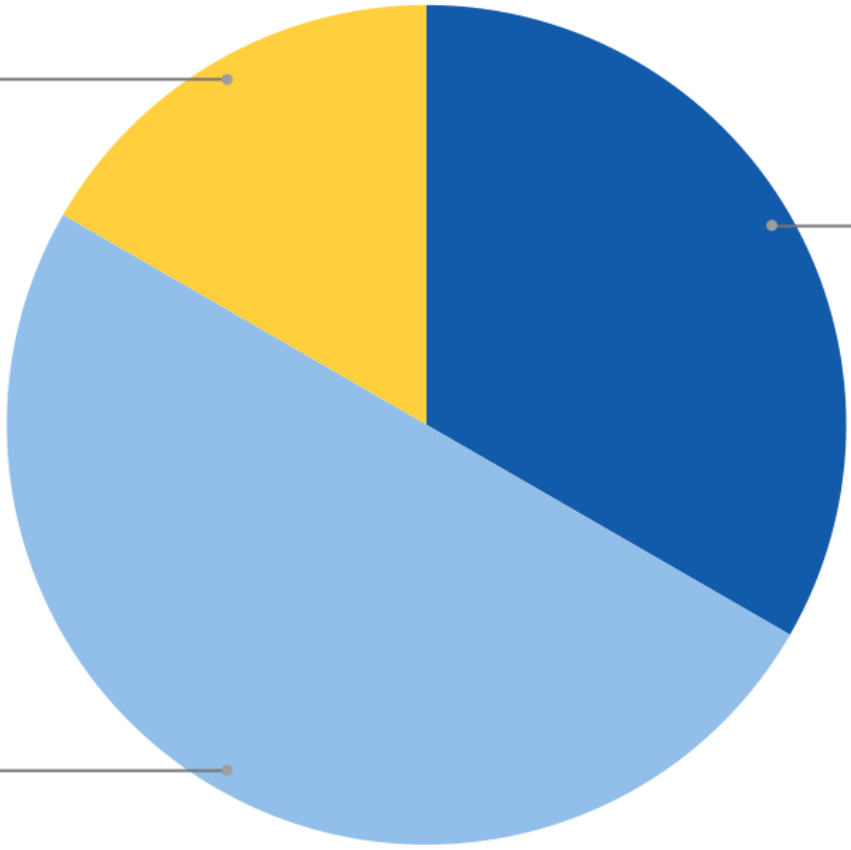

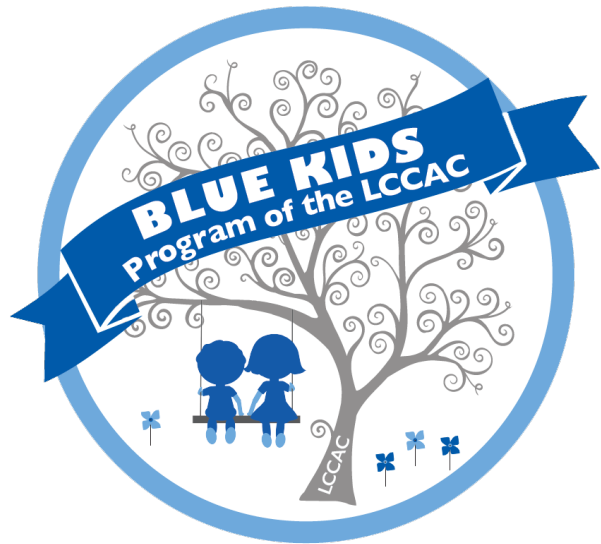

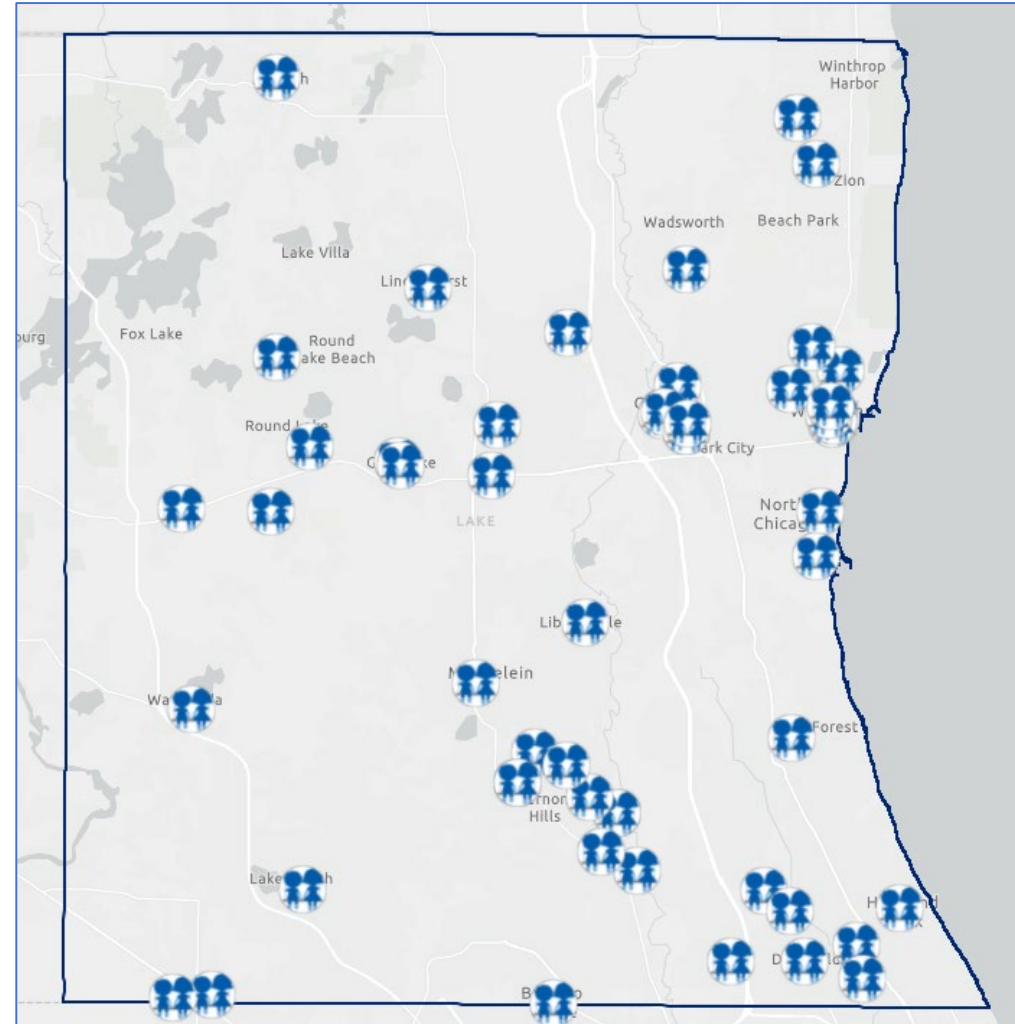

Navigating and Preventing Child Abuse

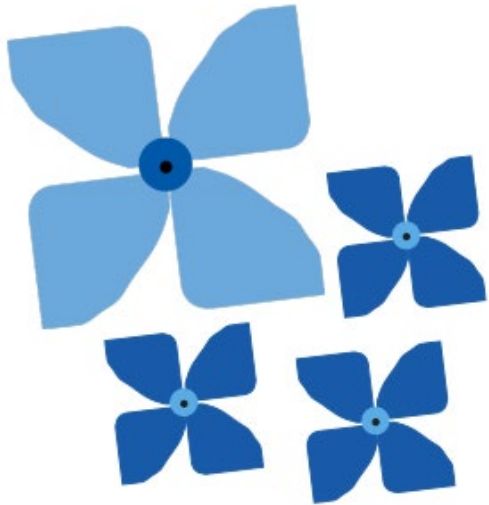
- ✓ Practice open communication with children
