



90% of Water/Wastewater Operators are IEPA Licensed


Laboratory is IEPA and IDPH Certified for Water and Wastewater Testing

Budget - FY'22



- Operation = \$37M
- Capital = \$18M
 (5-yr CIP) = >\$64M
 (10-yr CIP) = >\$187M






