MODIFICATION #2 OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT REGARDING REGIONAL 911 CONSOLIDATION TO EXTEND ITS TERM

This Modification is between the County of Lake ("County"), an Illinois body politic and corporate, and its Lake County Emergency Telephone System Board organized under the provisions of 50 ILCS 750/1, et seq.; the Lake County Sheriff; the City of Waukegan, an Illinois home rule municipal corporation; the City of North Chicago, an Illinois home rule municipal corporation; the Northeast Lake County Consolidated Joint Emergency Telephone Systems Board, an Emergency Telephone System Board organized under the provisions of 50 ILCS 750/1, et seq.; the Village of Gurnee, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Mundelein, an Illinois home rule municipal corporation; the Village of Libertyville, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Lincolnshire, an Illinois home rule municipal corporation; the Village of Vernon Hills, an Illinois home rule municipal corporation; the Vernon Hills/Libertyville/Lincolnshire Joint Emergency Telephone Systems Board, an Emergency Telephone System Board organized under the provisions of 50 ILCS 750/1, et seq.; the Village of Round Lake Beach, an Illinois home rule municipal corporation; the Village of Round Lake, an Illinois municipal corporation; CenCom, an Emergency Telephone System Board organized under the provisions of 50 ILCS 750/1, et seq.; the Greater Round Lake Fire Protection District, a Fire Protection District organized under the Illinois Fire Protection District Act, 70 ILCS 705/1, et seq.; the Wauconda Fire Protection District, a Fire Protection District organized under the Illinois Fire Protection District Act, 70 ILCS 705/1, et seq.; the Village of Fox Lake, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Barrington, an Illinois municipal corporation, the Grayslake Fire Protection District, a Fire Protection District organized under the Illinois Fire Protection District Act, 70 ILCS 705/1, et seq.; and the Countryside Fire Protection District, a Fire Protection District organized under the Illinois Fire Protection District Act, 70 ILCS 705/1, et seq., referred to individually as the "Party" or collectively, as the "Parties."

Recitals

- 1. In an agreement titled *Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Regional 911 Consolidation* and made effective September 6, 2018 (the "Consolidation IGA"), twenty-one governmental entities partnered to create "a detailed analysis of the costs and benefits of 911 consolidation," and endeavored "to create an implementation plan for consolidated 911 communication services."
- 2. The Consolidation IGA set forth a governance structure and other procedures that its signatories have followed over the two years since that IGA's inception.
- 3. The initial term of the Consolidation IGA was two years from its effective date, but the Parties continue to work to achieve the goals they set forth in that document. For that reason, the Parties seek to extend the term of the Consolidation IGA for a second time through this Modification.

In light of the foregoing, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the Consolidation IGA, as set forth in its § 4.3, shall be extended from September 6, 2020 (its original end date) for a second additional year to September 6, 2022.
- 2. Aside from the extension of the Consolidation IGA's term, all other provisions of the Consolidation IGA shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. The Parties may sign this modification in several counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original but all of which together will constitute one instrument.

WHEREAS, the City of Waukegan partnered in the development of a resolution of support passed by all participating public safety entities and the creation of the Regional 9-1-1 Consolidation Consortium ("Consortium") charged with developing an implementation and migration plan for 9-1-1 consolidation in Lake County pursuant to that certain "Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Regional 911 Consolidation," dated as of September 6, 2018 ("Intergovernmental Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the two-year Intergovernmental Agreement outlined the purpose of the Regional 9-1-1 Consolidation Committees, the expected expenditure of the collected funds, and the timeline of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Waukegan is an active Regional 9-1-1 Consolidation Consortium partner supporting ongoing consolidation analysis and planning, continuation as a member of the Consortium is in the best interest of Waukegan's residents.
