12. Lake County Community Health Center Governing Council Update

Mark Pfister reported that at the Governing Council meeting on August 9, 2022, Director Kim Burke presented on the Health Department's annual needs assessment. The Council saw it as useful and being of great value because it was by zip code and listed the services

being provided to patients in those zip codes which is a good indicator of whether or not we are providing the right services in the right locations. As an example, it was identified that our younger patients from Zion, North Chicago, Waukegan and Round Lake were going to the North Shore Health Center because that's where the pediatrician had open appointment slots. Dr. Zun and Kim spoke with the pediatrician and she is going to be moved to the Grand Avenue Clinic so that she is more centrally located for those patients which is the purpose of the needs assessment, to make sure we are accessible and not creating other social determinants of health issues such as transportation. A great job by our health informatics team on putting that data together, by the practice managers for reviewing it, and leadership for identifying a change valuable to our patients.

Lisa Kritz, Director of Prevention, informed the Board that the TB Board passed their FY2023 budget for \$691,000, a little over \$115,000 less than their FY2022 budget.
