


LCTV Infrastructure Renovation and AV Technology Upgrades

Reasons for Upgrade

- Existing technology is:
 - Outdated
 - No longer supported
 - Must be converted from digital (only items available now) to analog which is not efficient
 - At-Risk with single point of failure
- Patchwork fixes increasing in frequency
- Standard Definition picture quality is blurry





New Upgrade Provides

- More efficient workspace
- Equipment that is supported and meets industry standards
- One support and service infrastructure contract for LCTV Control Room and some equipment in the Board Room

Estimated Total Cost



- \$545,970: AV Infrastructure and Equipment
 – For Approval Today
- \$205,000: HVAC, Mechanical, Electrical, Fiber Optics Line (Facilities)
 - Work performed through Job Order Contracting JOC
 - \$6,000: Network Switch Department purchase (EIT)
- <u>Total</u>
 - \$756,970 paid for through PEG capital reserves

Impacts During Construction



- Summer start date pending equipment arrival
- Construction over 4–6 weeks
 - Lakecounty.tv will remain operational
 - LCTV channels on AT&T and Comcast will be down
- Three on-the-ground cameras will be used to record Lake County Board meetings
 - County Board meetings will still be posted online
 - Meetings will still be accessible live through Zoom
