

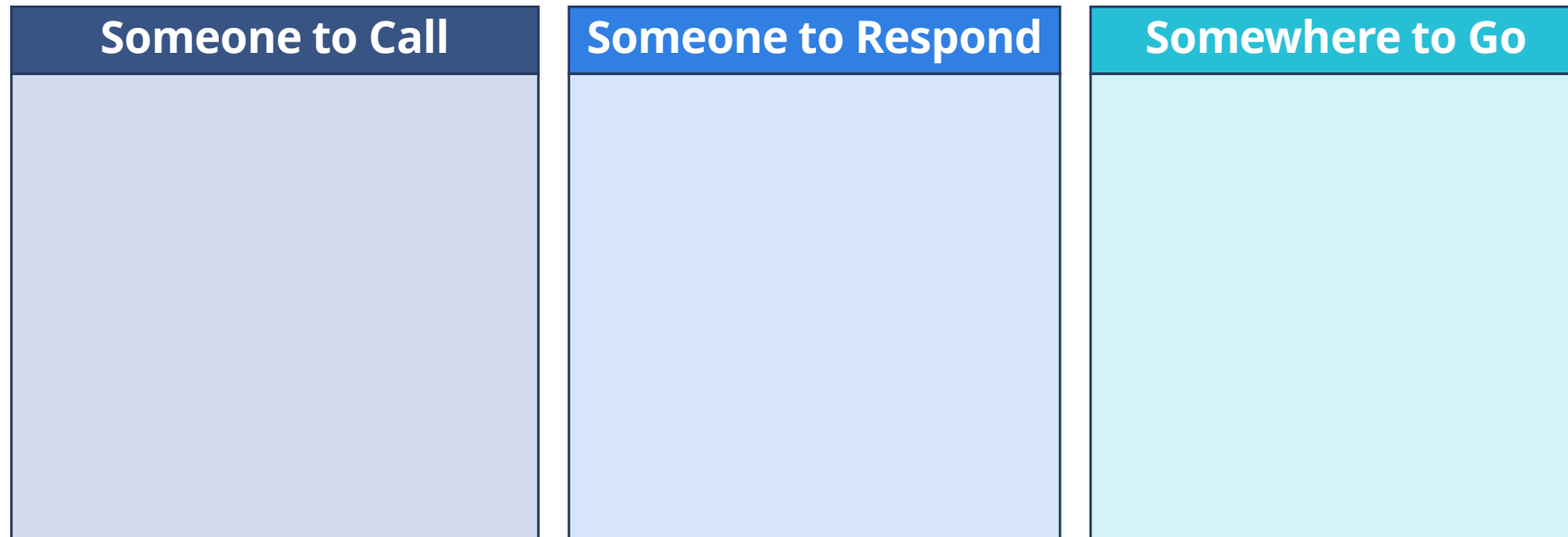

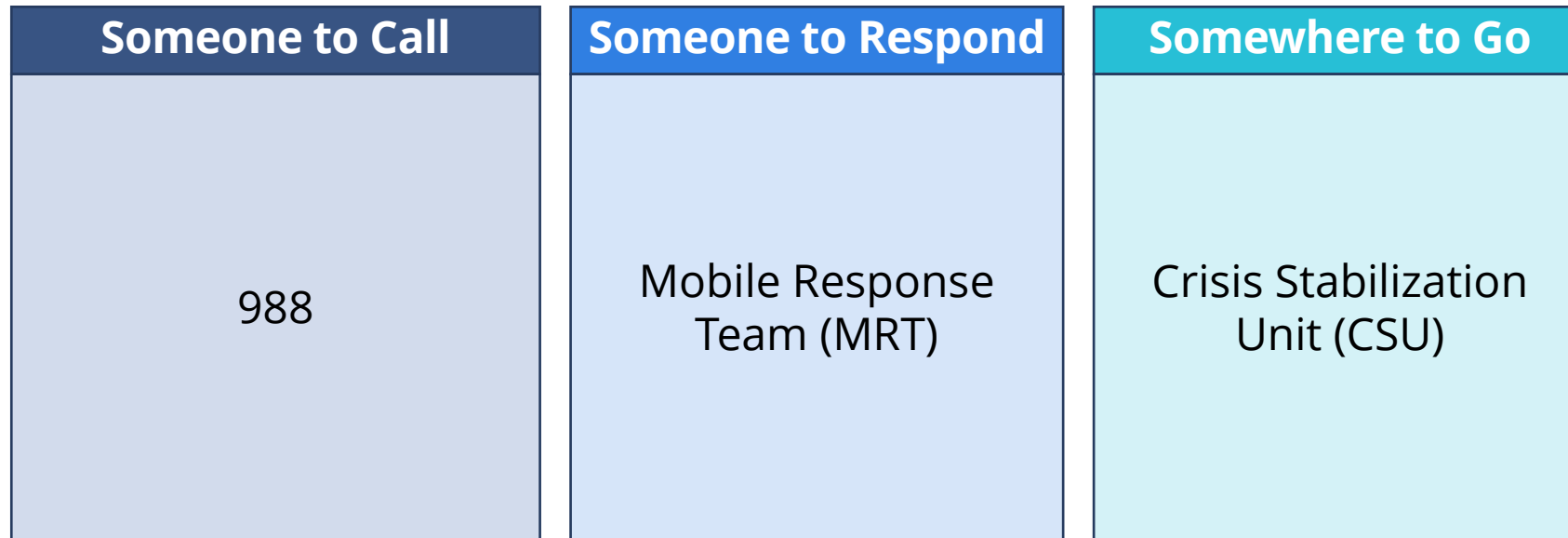
Expanding Crisis Services: SAMHSA's Vision

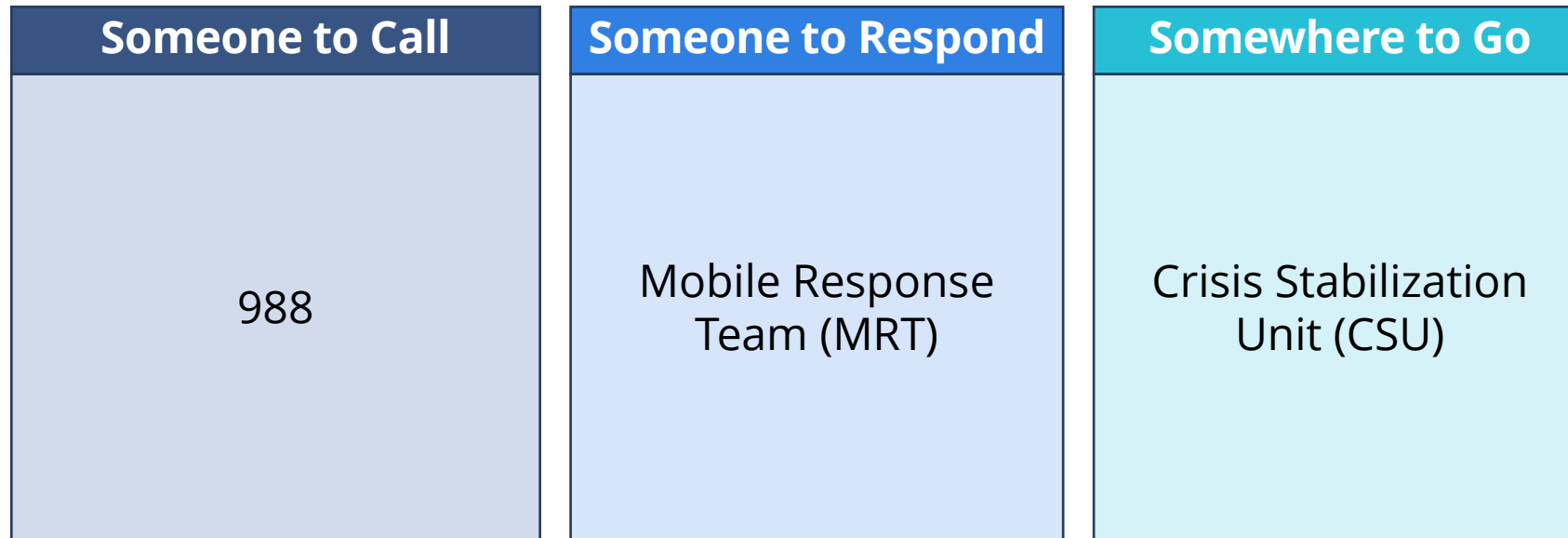

- Grant received last year: \$462,000
- Went live July 2022
- 878 calls answered

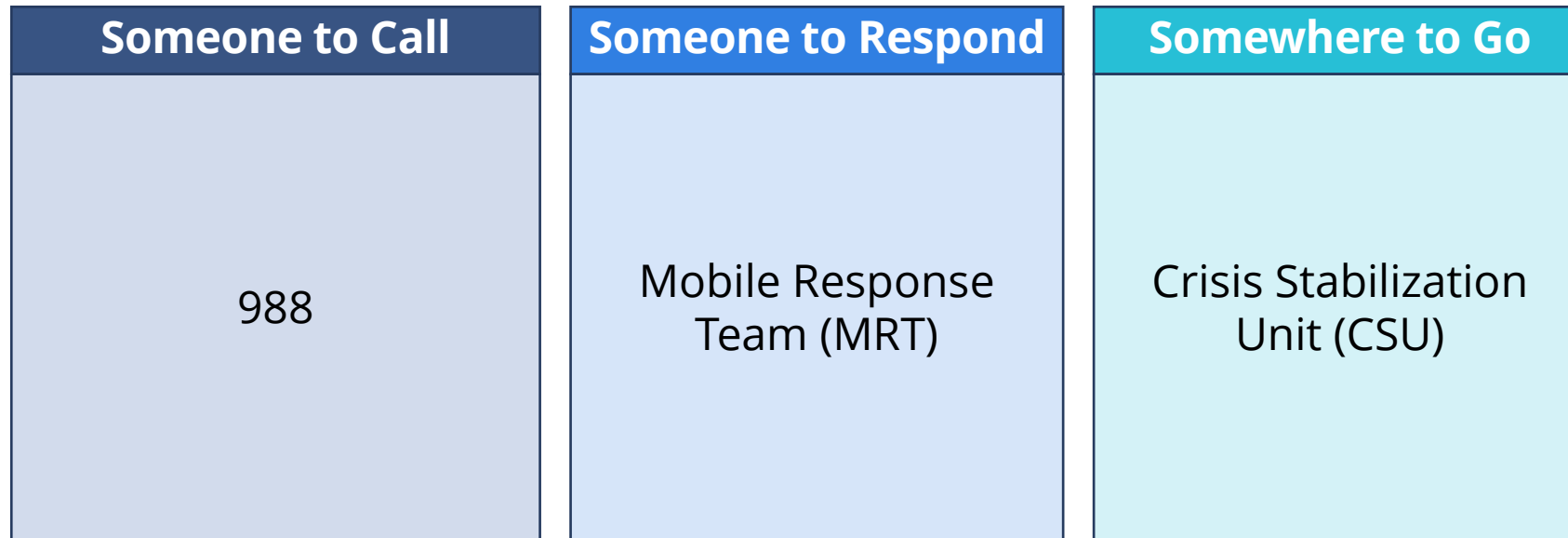
Someone to Respond

Mobile Response Team (MRT)

- SAMHSA Goal: 80% of people have access by end of 2025
- Grant received last year: \$1.9M
- Went live March 2022
- 99 mobile responses so far

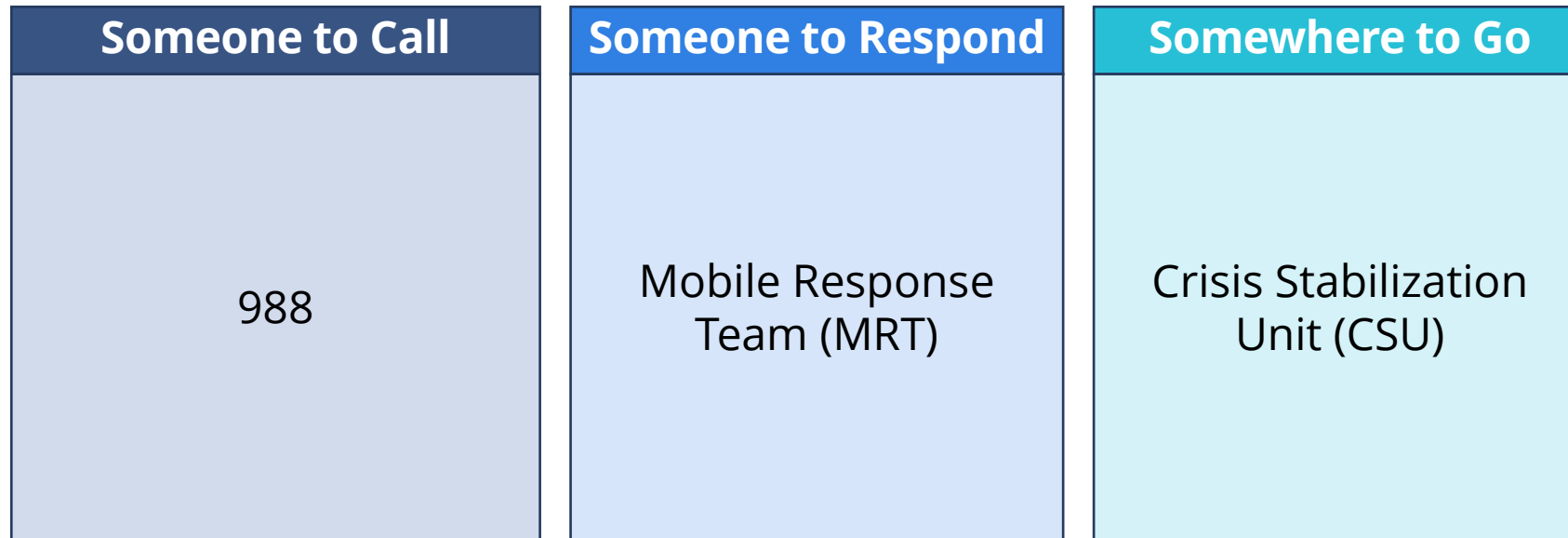

- Crisis Care Program Respite (11 in IL)

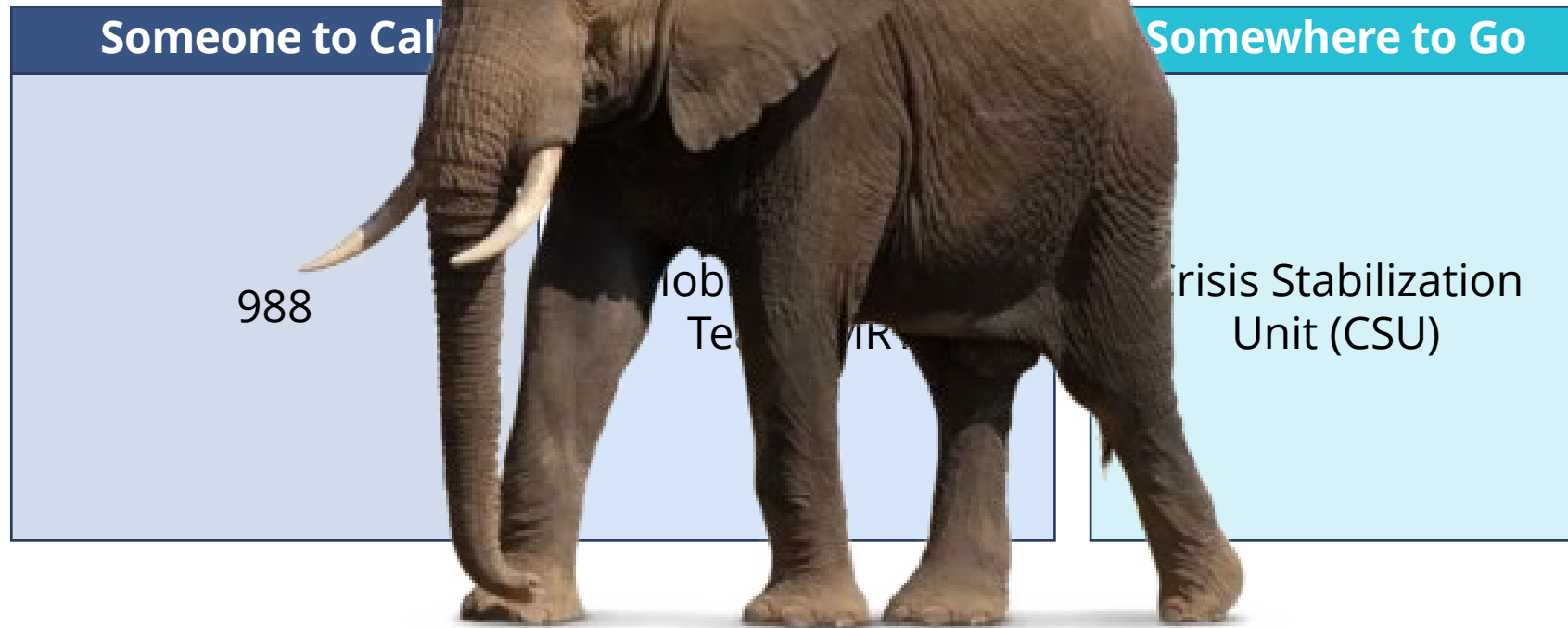
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CCSO: Care Coordination and Support Organization

Response to the N.B. Consent Decree

Reimbursement-based contract, with some ARPA start-up money (\$437,500)

Very specific staffing patterns and caseload limits
