RE: North Branch Chicago River and Lake Michigan Watershed-Based Plans Public Comment Period

ACTION REQUESTED: OPEN 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR EACH PLAN

Staff requests that the Lake County Stormwater Management Commission open a 30-day public comment period for the North Branch Chicago River Watershed-Based Plan and for the Lake Michigan Watershed-Based Plan. SMC has worked since 2018 to develop draft watershed-based plans for each planning area. Numerous public agencies and units of government played a key role, including Lake County departments; the Forest Preserve District; dozens of municipalities and townships, North Shore Water Reclamation District, drainage districts, Illinois DNR, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) and the North Branch Chicago River Watershed Workgroup. SMC held public meetings as well as targeted focus discussions with local units of government and land management organizations in each watershed to inform the plans.

Center, Deerfield)

March 9th Lake Michigan Watershed Plan public information meeting (Waukegan Public Library)

March 15th Public Hearing at County Seat (County Building, Waukegan)

April 6th Public review period ends May/June Request adoption by the SMC

June-August County Board Committees and Adoption
