Request for a one-time increase to base pay

### **Action Requested:**

Recommend the approval of an additional 7% increase to base pay (for a total of a 17% increase in base pay) for the Assistant Building Official, position number 34057.

#### **Analysis:**

The Assistant Building Official was recruited by another local government agency. To prevent the County from losing this employee, the County Administrator authorized a one-time increase in pay of 10%. However, this still does not equal the amount in salary which the other Community offered.

Therefore, Human Resources recommends authorizing an additional increase above the 10% (the total increase would be 17% from their original salary or what we refer to as "baseline"). The employee currently serving as the Assistant Building Official has marketable skills and certifications which are presently in high demand.

Continuity is important for positions in this department and the role of the Assistant Building Official is critical to the economic development of the County and the contracts in place with municipalities.

The Director of Human Resources recommends approval of a one-time total increase of 17% to bring the employee in the Assistant Building Official position (number 34057) to an annual salary of \$95,226.30.
