The Sheriff's Department has 44 vehicles on its current replacement schedule, 15 of which were from FY2022 and FY2021 that were unable to be obtained due to supply chain issues. Seven of these vehicles have already been retired, taking them out of operation. The significant backlog is having an impact on department operations and could potentially impact public safety.

Working with the Division of Transportation, we have deemed the following vehicles as the most critical replacements due to their age, mileage and point score, which indicates overall condition. This is necessary to minimize serious disruption of government services.
