





# **2022-2023 Highlights**



#### Shared Services and Other Efficiencies:

- Adopted IGA with SMC to incorporate "FIL-50" stormwater fee-in-lieu program
- Continue to oversee consolidated waste hauling agreements
- Renewed temporary enforcement inspection program (lower cost, seasonal efficiencies)
- Currently negotiating multiple IGA renewals for shared services
- Completed upgrade of permitting software (EnerGov) to accommodate additional efficiencies

# **2022-2023 Highlights**



#### Regulatory Highlights

- Adopted "nature-based" text amendments (wildlife rehabilitation, eco-therapy & animal exhibitions)
- Adopted State-required ordinance amendments related to wind and solar energy facilities
- Adopted site development amendments to expand stormwater capacity for development projects
- CRS Recertification retained rating as a Class 6 (20% discount on flood insurance premiums) via increased flood protection requirements, public education, etc.


#### Sustainability

- Worked with CAO to successfully coordinate initiation and passage of "bird-friendly building design" bill (passed both chambers in May 2023)
- Initiated reviews of multiple commercial solar projects (157 acres) and approved 179 (FY22) residential solar projects (up 72% from FY21)

#### **Permit Revenue**




#### Total Revenue / Year: January - April & Permit Type



#### **Permit Revenue**




#### **Total Permit Fees / Year: January - April**



#### **IGA Revenue**








#### **Permit Trend**




#### **Count of Permits / Year: January - April**

# 2023-2024 Looking Ahead



#### Shared Services and Other Efficiencies:

- Renewing existing intergovernmental agreements for shared services (7)
- Continuing to explore new "mutual aid" intergovernmental agreements and expansion of existing intergovernmental agreements throughout the County
- Updating the department's IGA rate study for intergovernmental agreements
- Completing comprehensive updates to the building codes
- Implementing Samsara within the department to explore additional efficiencies

# 2023-2024 Looking Ahead



- Regulatory Improvements
  - Completing UDO text amendments relating to various policy topics (including sustainability-related)
    - Native Trees and Plants Initiative
    - Sustainability Incentives Ordinance
    - Bird Friendly Design Regulations
    - Regulations for Fill/Grade Operations
    - Affordable Housing Policy Options
    - Dark Sky Lighting Policy Options
    - WDO Ordinance Amendments/FEMA Maps
