Re: Emergency Solutions Grant Program Year 2014 Funding Recommendations

On March 19, the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) released final funding amounts for Lake County's 2014 program year. Lake County will receive \$197,178 in total funding, a \$27,348 increase over PY2013. The final funding amount is \$25,140 greater than the estimates used to develop funding recommendations. As a result, grantee funding levels need to change.

The Homeless Application Review Committee (ARC) made initial funding recommendations based on the assumption of flat funding and included the repurposing of some contingency funds. Staff used the following methodology to determine the revised funding amounts.

- Followed the direction from the ARC to fund Most Blessed Trinity if funding is increased by greater than \$10,000.
- Maintained the percentage of total funding in each program type to remain consistent with the top-down methodology from the ARC.

- Used pro rata methodology to assign additional dollars within program type.
- Did not let grant awards exceed the requested amount.
- Do not let the total funding to shelter programs exceed the 60% restriction from HUD.
