

Coroner's Monthly Report of Investigations conducted for the month of October, 2014:

Return to Doctor Cases: (1)	362
Coroner's Cases: (2), (3)	33
Total Death Investigations:	395

Total death investigations for October, 2014: 395

Total death investigations for October, 2013: 372

(1) Return to Medical Professional Cases:

Minimal Investigation is needed; primarily consisting of review of medical history, medical records, and discussion with health care providers involved in the case.

(2) Inquiry Cases:

More extensive investigation is required to determine whether death is from natural or "unnatural" causes; and excluding causes or manner of death mandating Coroner's Inquest.

(3) Inquest Cases

Thorough investigation as to the cause of death, with subsequent Case Conference to determine the manner of death (i.e., homicide, suicide, accidental, or undetermined). Inquest cases are mandated by Illinois Statute by type of death.
