Presentation on the Lake County Behavioral Health Treatment Court Collaborative .

- Discussion on Mental Health and its impact on the Jail and Judicial System.

*Amy McEwan gave a brief introduction on the mental illness challenges presented to the County. Rose Gray, Director of Adult Probation of Lake County presented to the Committee. In 2014 Lake County was awarded a grant. The grant is known as the Lake County Behavioral Health Treatment Court Collaborative. The grant was written by NACASA and it's intent is to address several needs for high need individuals on probation.*

*Steve Fabre, Assistant Director of Probation Department, continued the presentation addressing the heroin problem in Lake County. There is an increase of death from heroin in this county. Drug and alcohol use is affecting 41,000 people in Lake County. Part of the focus of the grant is to get the different service entities to work together in collaboration to assist the probationers who have mental health issues or drug addiction. More stakeholders are continuing to be added to the collaborative to get the system of recovery going and sustaining that system.*

*With this grant Lake County is receiving:*

- dual diagnosis counselors who work with the population who have anti social behavior*
- housing advocate*
- recovery specialist*
- information system to share information across agencies*
- comprehensive training*
- mapping to divert people away from the criminal justice system and into services*

*Amy McEwan shared one thing that has come out in the studies is that this has to be a community solution. It has to be collaborative. It is a challenge but it's a goal to treat the whole patient including housing, employment and transportation.*

*Committee members thanked the Probation Department for their work on this grant and for presenting the information to the Committee.*
