You must be prepared for some frustration, hostility, and occasionally some verbal abuse from appellants who did not get the decision they were hoping for. You must keep your composure and conduct the hearing in a fair and professional manner.

3. It is critical that all appellants know they've received a fair and objective hearing, all of their evidence was considered, and someone listened & paid attention to their concerns. If time allows, you must be willing to answer questions.

I believe I meet these requirements and ask to be reappointed as a permanent member of the Board of Review.
