LAKE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT COOPERATIVE STATE AND LOCAL AGREEMENT

This agreement is made this 1st day of October, 2016, between the United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (hereinafter "DEA"), and the Lake County, Illinois Sheriff's Department (hereinafter "LCSD"). The DEA is authorized to enter into this cooperative agreement concerning the use and abuse of controlled substances under the provisions of 21 U.S.C. § 873.

WHEREAS there is evidence that trafficking in narcotics and dangerous drugs exists in the Chicagoland area and that such illegal activity has a substantial and detrimental effect on the health and general welfare of the people of Illinois, the parties hereto agree to the following:

- 1. The Chicago Field Division (CFD) will perform the activities and duties described below:
- a. disrupt the illicit drug traffic in the area by immobilizing targeted violators and trafficking organizations;
- b. gather and report intelligence data relating to trafficking in narcotics and dangerous drugs; and
- c. conduct undercover operations where appropriate and engage in other traditional methods of investigation in order that the CFD activities will result in effective prosecution before the courts of the United States and the State of Illinois
- 2. To accomplish the objectives of the CFD, the LCSD agrees to detail one experienced officer to the CFD for a period of not less than two years. During this period of assignment, the officer will be under the direct supervision and control of DEA supervisory personnel assigned to the CFD.
- 3. The LCSD officer assigned to the CFD shall adhere to DEA policies and procedures. Failure to adhere to DEA policies and procedures shall be grounds for dismissal from the CFD.
- 4. The LCSD officer assigned to the CFD shall be deputized as a Task Force Officer of DEA pursuant to 21 U.S.C. Section 878.
- 5. To accomplish the objectives of the CFD, DEA will assign nine Special Agents to the CFD. DEA will also, subject to the availability of annually appropriated funds or any continuing resolution thereof, provide necessary funds and equipment to support the activities of the DEA Special Agents and officers assigned to the CFD. This support will include: office space, office

supplies, travel funds, funds for the purchase of evidence and information, investigative equipment, training, and other support items.

- 6. The LCSD shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended, and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the regulations of the United States Department of Justice implementing those laws, 28 C.F.R. Part 42, Subparts C, F, G, H and I.
- 7. The term of this agreement shall be effective from the date specified in the opening paragraph until September 30, 2017. This agreement may be terminated by either party on thirty days' advance written notice. Billing for all outstanding obligations must be received by DEA within 90 days of the date of termination of this agreement. DEA will be responsible only for obligations incurred by LCSD during the term of this agreement.
