REQUEST FROM DEPARTMENT:

Department submitted a request for a joint purchasing procurement for High Density mobile storage. There is a need to provide and install a high-density mobile storage system for the new Multi-Departmental Storage Facility project that will provide pass-thru lockers, shelving sections, powered mobile carriages, and space-saving rail systems which will efficiently secure various evidence and property items being stored by the Sheriff's Office and Clerk of the Circuit Court.

SCOPE OF WORK:

A quote was submitted by Bradford Systems on January 30th, 2017 which proposed to provide the pass-thru lockers, shelving sections, powered mobile carriages, and space-saving rail systems that meet the departments storage needs.
