On April 11, 2006 the County Board approved a competitively solicited contract with Cott Systems, Inc., Columbus, OH, to provide a turn-key records management service to support the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, which includes hardware, software, and annual maintenance required to operate the program.

Cott Systems, Inc. is the sole proprietor and, as the only source that can provide the services, was approved for bid exemption by the Purchasing Agent in 2009 and renewed in 2013.

In accordance with Article 6, Section 102 of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, the Purchasing Agent approved bid exemption on the basis that there exists a long standing, successful relationship for professional services, and the knowledge gained through this relationship adds value integral to the services provided for these services.
