Bid/RFP Exemption

Intent:

In 1998 SDSC created and implemented CRIMS to meet the needs of the Circuit Court Clerk. In the ensuing years a system was created for the State's Attorney, and Public Defender.

Scope of Work:

The new contract provides for the continued maintenance and support for the current case management systems for the 19th Judicial Circuit Court, Circuit Court Clerk, Public Defender and State's Attorney's Office.

Bid Exemption Recommendation:

Software Development and Services Corporation (SDSC) is the sole proprietor and, as the only source that can provide the software maintenance and support services.

In accordance with Article 6, Section 102 of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, the Purchasing Agent approved bid exemption on the basis that there exists a long standing, successful relationship for professional services, and the knowledge gained through this relationship adds value integral to the services provided for these services.
