### Intent:

It is the intent of the Department of Public Work to Purchase a Wet Chemistry Autoanalyzer.

# Scope of Work:

- I. The scope of work is to secure an autoanalyzer that is capable of:
- a) Handling drinking water and wastewater (including raw influents)
- b) Simultaneously processing analyses on same sample fraction
- c) Auto-diluting high concentrations
- d) Programming quality control requirements and limits
- e) Performing sample reruns
- f) Raw data storage

II. Location:

The instrument would be located/installed at the Lake County Environmental Laboratory – 500 Winchester Rd, Libertyville, IL 60048

#### III. Training:

The selected vendor shall be prepared to provide on-site training. It is expected that this training will be for a small group of Analyst (3 - 4 staff).

#### IV. Software:

The analyzer should have software that is compatible a currently supported version of Windows. The software should be pre-loaded. Vendor should provide the appropriate desktop and printer for management of the analyzer.
