Joint Purchase Information

Scope of Work:

Lake County Facilities has identified the need for additional temporary resources to augment its existing staff due to the opening of new buildings and the upcoming closure of the Winchester House detectors. ACRO Service Corporation will secure staffing for Winchester House through their network of staffing agencies.

Procurement Method:

Purchasing identified a cooperative purchasing contract through U.S. Communities (#16111) with ACRO Service Corporation that was competitively solicited and awarded. Pursuant to Article 10-101 of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, Cooperative Purchasing, Lake County may participate in a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of goods with one or more public procurement units in accordance with an agreement entered into between the participants. The RFP was led by the lead agency of Maricopa County, Phoenix, AZ.

Department Recommendation:

The Purchasing Division vetted the contract through U.S. Communities (#16111) with ACRO Service Corporation and determined that it met the requirements pursuant to State of Illinois Joint Purchasing Act and the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance. Lake County may participate in joint purchasing agreements for the procurement of goods with one or more public procurement units in accordance with an agreement entered into between the participants.
