RE: Intergovernmental Agreement with Village of Libertyville for the Charles Brown Park Wetland

Detention and Forebays Project

ACTION REQUESTED: APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT WITH VILLAGE OF LIBERTYVILLE - \$135,987.50

SMC staff requests approval to execute an intergovernmental agreement to reimburse the Village of Libertyville for an amount not-to-exceed \$135,987.50 for Charles Brown Park Wetland Detention and Forebays Project. The not-to-exceed amount is funded by an Illinois EPA Section 319 Clean Water Act grant approved by the Commission in July 2017. The Village of Libertyville will provide the required minimum \$140,387.50 in cost-share match required. This replaces another project that did not proceed after the Section 319 grant was awarded. SMC worked closely with Illinois EPA in selecting and approving the Charles Brown Park project as a replacement project for the grant.

The grant award will provide cost-share funding on a reimbursement basis for 9.9 acres of wetland detention and 0.8 acres of sediment forebays in Charles Brown Park. The project is located on land owned by the Village on the north side of the Seavey Ditch. The total project cost is \$806,507.50.

SMC will administer the grant and provide professional/technical assistance services to the Village. SMC will receive reimbursement from the Section 319 grant for these services. A draft of the agreement with the Village of Libertyville is attached.
