Re: FY 2019 WMB Application Summary

ACTION REQUESTED: APPROVAL OF WMB FUNDING RECOMMENDATION

At the annual Watershed Management Board (WMB) meeting on December 5, 2018, the Board recommends the noted projects on the attached list for WMB funding. A description for recommended projects follows the summary information and project location maps can be found here: <u>https://arcg.is/11mPWT</u>. There were (15) fifteen project proposals totaling \$5,048,095 and requesting \$397,376 of WMB funds. A total of \$183,000 is available for WMB funding. SMC staff requests the approval of the following WMB funding recommendations:

- (6) six WMB projects, with a total project cost of \$4,561,005 and total WMB funding of \$170,760
- (1) one Watershed Management Assistance Grant (WMAG), with a total project cost of \$12,000 and a total WMAG funding of \$12,000.

The WMB recommendations to the Commission include transfer of funding between watersheds due to unallocated funds in both the Lake Michigan and the Des Plaines River Watersheds.

All WMB project agreements that exceed the Executive Director's spending authority of \$20,000 will be presented to the Commission for approval at a future meeting.

WATERSHED MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE GRANT (WMAG)

The WMAG supports the growth and sustainability (i.e., organizational capacity) of local watershed partnerships in Lake County. For the purpose of this program, the definition of a "watershed partnership" is an inclusive, enduring, diverse, community-based group organized to identify and resolve watershed problems and issues. The work carried out by each grant recipient will target and fulfill the above purpose. There is no local match requirement for WMAG.

Squaw Creek Watershed Plan (Long Lake Improvement & Sanitation Assoc.) \$12,000 SMC WMAG Grant \$12,000 Estimated Project Cost The Squaw Creek Water Alliance will use the WMAG to support the development and implementation of the Squaw Creek Watershed Plan update.

The proposed project scope of work involves hydrologic and hydraulic modeling for the Tower Lakes watershed, to assist with prioritizing remaining projects, identifying additional projects, and supporting assessment and engineering design of future projects.

The WMB and SMC staff **<u>DO NOT RECOMMEND</u>** this project for WMB funding.

The proposed project scope of work includes removing accumulated debris and sediment from the stormwater system within the subdivision to provide drainage relief and restore functionality to the constructed rill system.

The WMB and SMC staff $\underline{\mbox{DO NOT RECOMMEND}}$ this project for WMB funding.

The proposed scope of work includes 400 LF. of perimeter repair at Grass Island using approximately 1 ton of riprap per linear foot to protect the constructed wetland habitat in the interior of the island.

The WMB and SMC staff $\underline{\mbox{DO NOT RECOMMEND}}$ this project for WMB funding.

The proposed scope of work includes ultimately installing 2,250 LF. of 6-24" boulders starting at the worst area of Lake Marie shoreline, with additional work performed each year as supported by budget.

The WMB and SMC staff $\underline{\mbox{DO NOT RECOMMEND}}$ this project for WMB funding.

The proposed project scope includes constructing a berm and retaining wall to prevent flooding of the facility, installing new storm sewer to drain water back to the lake via a pump system, and establish a native plant raingarden that includes "sensory garden" species for people with limited mobility.

The WMB and SMC staff **<u>RECOMMEND</u>** this project for WMB funding.

The proposed project scope includes the clean-up of approximately 200 ft. of creek, drainage ditch enhancements, storm sewer inlet and pipe installation, as well as installation of rock riffle and rock toe treatments.

The WMB and SMC staff **DO NOT RECOMMEND** this project for WMB funding.
