

Job Order Contracting Project Selection Criteria Checklist

Remodeling and Infrastructure

- Does the proposed project budget less than \$350,000 and;
- Contain a majority of construction tasks that are pre-priced in the CTC and;
 - o Include multi-trades requiring a supervising contractor for coordination purposes

or:

o Impact space occupied by staff or contain other facility sensitive components

or;

Require an unusual schedule or quality of construction

or;

o Realize cost savings through the elimination of consulting services relative to the project

Repetitive Remodeling and Infrastructure

- Does the proposed project budget exceed \$350,000 that will it be phased over multiple years and;
- Contain a majority of construction tasks that are pre-priced in the CTC and:
 - O Contain repetitive replacement or remodeling that will require consistency of materials or specifications over more than one project

or;

- o Contain project phasing or complexity that impacts staffing, scheduling or productivity or:
 - Requires an unusual schedule or quality of construction that is not cost effective in the public bidding environment

Emergency Repairs

- Does not have a project budget and;
- Contain a majority of construction tasks that are pre-priced in the CTC and;
 - o The work needs to be performed without delay in accordance with an emergency declaration or;
 - o The work would normally be performed as a sole source declaration

or;

• The work would normally be performed as a change order to a traditionally bid project, however, pricing cannot be agreed to with the traditional bid project
