

Volumes in Need of Restoration / Preservation




 Genealogical Records – Birth Records, Marriage Records, Indices, etc. This collection totals 110 volumes, of which 17,075 pgs. have been preserved; 34,204 pgs. have not been preserved (66.7%).

Loose pages separated from binding at risk of being lost. Pages are brittle.



Supervisor's Records – 92
volumes, totaling 55,383 pgs.
Bound in leather with gold
stamping, none of the books
have been restored.

Bindings are broken; condition of pages, however, is quite good.



Scope of Project



- Byers Printing Co. would propose the following:
- Scan the Collection. Scanning the books in question provides a backup to the collection, and also provides you with the foundation for an online access point if you decide to do that in the future.
- Restore Books. For the genealogical records that are handled often we recommend encapsulating the pages (lamination) and rebinding the books in new record binders. The Supervisor's records are in much better condition; for these books we would recommend rebinding the select books that have broken bindings. We could encapsulate these books as well if desired. Our recommendation would be to leave the pages as is and simply rebind the books that are damaged.

Book Scanning



- Byers Printing Co. would use a large format (A1+) book scanner that would be used on the large record books. This type of scanner enables archival quality, high resolution scans.
- Given the time it takes to scan, you do not want to settle for low-quality scans and run the risk of having to re-scan the originals in the future.
- Maximum scanning speed is approximately 2 books (320 pgs. each) per hour.

Cost: \$0.25 per pg.



Restoration Process – New Binder w/ Lamination







Restoration Process - Rebind Book



This is an example of the end result of the rebinding process without lamination. New covers, gold stamping to match originals, and new end papers. We could rebind the Supervisor's record books in similar fashion with materials of your choice; it would be your choice if you wanted to match the originals as closely as possible or simply rebind in a durable, cost effective manner.

Access to Books during Restoration



- We would pickup/deliver books twice a week, in order to minimize the time that books are away from Lake County. We would only take the books that we are going to scan and restore, likely 30-35 books at a time.
- All books that are in the possession of Byers Printing Co. for scanning can be accessed from Mon. – Fri., 8am – 4pm at 3500 Constitution Dr., Springfield, IL 62711.



 For convenience, we can email scans of individuals pages of books if requested at anytime during normal working hours. We are typically able to send scans of the pages emailed to within 15 min. of the request.
