Assistant County Administrator Matt Meyers reviewed proposed edits for Ethics Ordinance which include amendments to the title, formatting, and the appointment of a third-party ethics advisor.

Mr. Meyers indicated that operating procedures will be included in a separate policy and is consistent with the language in the standards of conduct code. Discussion ensued regarding the ability to anonymously file complaints through a a third party system.

Human Resources Director Rodney Marion reviewed employee policies, noting that they do not apply to elected officials. Karen Fox, State's Attorney representative, indicated that the county board can only regulate its employees and its board members, noting that other elected offices are regulated by state statute. RuthAnn Hall, Purchasing, discussed third party employee contracts. Member Rummel suggested third party liability insurance coverage.

Discussion ensued regarding when employee conduct should be escalated to committee review. Complaints regarding aggregious behavior by staff will be heard on a periodic basis at the Financial and Administrative Committee.

Substantial discussion ensued regarding the process in handling board member and appointed official complaints.
