### **CHAIR'S REMARKS**

At our last special call meeting I talked about how hard ALL of our Lake County employees have been working, and that has not changed. Our county administrator's staff is collaborating with all departments, including those led by elected officials, to reduce our operating budget and prepare for a significant drop in revenue. They are working with the federal and state government on legislation and getting clear direction on how the funding we've received may be used in response to this crisis.

Most importantly, they have been in lockstep with the Lake County Health Department to ensure that all the PPE that has been donated and allocated to us is going to people in need, with a priority on our medical professionals, first responders, and people living and working in congregate settings, like nursing homes, assisted living developments, and our Lake County Jail. While we still haven't received 100% of what we've asked for, we are incredibly grateful for the numerous residents and businesses who have donated masks, face shields, gowns, and goggles.

Our team is working with counties across the Chicagoland area to share ideas, not just about managing through this pandemic, but about moving toward the light at the end of the tunnel. We're collaborating on the steps that must be taken to ensure that when people come back to work-at county government, in businesses across the county, and in Chicago-we have the correct measures in place to keep employees, customers, and residents safe.

We receive daily updates from Gary, and at finance yesterday there were more detailed reports from Jim, Matt, and Cassandra, so if you missed it you can listen in at the very end of the agenda.

So on behalf of the County Board, thank you to ALL of our staff for their leadership and commitment to the people of Lake County. We are really proud of our exceptional team.

I am also excited to announce the opening of the first Testing Facility right here in Waukegan, a community that has been disproportionately affected by COVID 19 and is, of course, our county seat.

Opening Day: Sunday, May 3, 2020

Hours: Open 7 days a week, 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. or until 500 tests are completed

Location: 2161 Northwestern Avenue, Waukegan, IL

Cost: Testing is free

Illinois National Guard Soldiers will be conducting tests

Test results within 4-7 days

All individuals with symptoms are encouraged to seek testing. Additional accommodations have been made for the following individuals with or without COVID-like symptoms:

Healthcare workers

First Responders

Employees of Correctional Facilities

Individuals exposed to confirmed COVID-19 patients

Employees that support Critical Infrastructure (grocery stores, pharmacies, restaurants,

gas stations, public utilities, factories, childcare and sanitation)

Individuals with compromised immune systems, chronic medical conditions Individuals slated to receive elective surgery within 72-hours

Definition of Symptoms

Fever, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell.

Know Before You Go:

Once you get in line at the CBTS, you will not be permitted to exit your car. For the safety of the testing personnel, the drive-thru sites will not be able to accommodate walk-up individuals. Individuals must arrive in a vehicle.

While this is a free service, you will be asked to show 1) photo identification and 2) healthcare employee or first responder ID/badge, if applicable.
