Each year the event grows – to date, nearly 3 million voters across all 50 states have registered on the day. Last year alone, 1.3 million registered. A project that big requires help, close to 20,000 volunteers work each year. Those volunteers are recruited by the 24 partners, including such organizations as the League of Women Voters, Google, Twitter, Facebook, Paypal, the YMCA and YWCA, etc., as well as approximately 1000 local community partners.

Ordinarily the efforts include tabling events at high schools, colleges, libraries, fairs – face to face efforts wherever people congregate. This year, obviously, things are different, and we are much more dependent on word of mouth and publicity to get the job done. Fortunately, Lake County has a superb ability to register voters on-line.
