- Analyzed data on impact of 13-valent pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV13) among adults aged 19-64 vears with chronic medical conditions and risk factors, such as heart disease, lung disease, diabetes, chronic liver disease, malignancies, tobacco use, and alcoholism. These data will be contributing evidence for the 2018 Advisory Committee of Immunization Practice's review of recommendations for PCV13 in U.S. adults.
