Lake County SMC's Regulatory Program


WDO first adopted October 18, 1992

Establish consistent, uniform, <u>minimum</u> county-wide requirements for new development.

Seek balanced input from:

- Governmental agencies
- Municipalities
- Environmental
- Property owners and developers

Done in a public forum.



Amendments History

There are several influences that necessitate revisions to the WDO:

- 1) FEMA/IDNR Mandates National Flood Insurance Program Updates
- 2) USEPA/IEPA Mandates Soil Erosion/Sediment Control Water Quality Issues NPDES
- 3) Illinois Compiled Statute Mandates Statutory Changes (Legal)
- 4) USACE/IEPA/IDNR Mandates Wetland Issues
- 5) Lake County/NE IL Inter/Intra-Countywide Issues

The timeline is usually about 5 years between major ordinance changes, summarized as follows:

October 18, 1992	ORIGINAL EFFECTIVE DATE
August 10, 1999	First major update
August 14, 2001	Added Isolated Wetland Section
January 10, 2006	Second overall update
July 10, 2012	Third overall update
October 13, 2015	Fourth update including re-formatting
October 13, 2020	Proposed update including increased rainfall




