During my professional career as an educator I served 20+ years as a superintendent of schools in three school districts in three different states.

1995 – 2004 – Community High School District 117, Lake Villa, Illinois

Prior to serving as superintendent of schools I held various administrative positions including principal of elementary schools in Tinley Park, Il and Ft. Knox, Ky. I also served as personnel director at the Ft. Knox Dependent Schools. In addition, I was a teacher in two school districts in Indiana (Elkhart and Mishawaka).
