RE: Update regarding the use of Job Order Contracting (JOC) for multiple

projects exceeding \$350,000

1. Lake County established an internal policy in June 2019 for JOC Project Guideline and Project Development Protocol that identified a threshold of \$350,000, at which the Finance and Administrative Committee should be advised of projects anticipated to exceed the threshold.

- 2. As part of the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget Process, funding was appropriated as part of the Capital Improvement Program. Projects exceeding the \$350,000 threshold:
  - a. Structural Reinforcement of the Adult Probation Bowstring Roof Trusses to include: replacement of compromised top and bottom cords, reinforcement of truss webbing, installation of supplementary steel gussets and tension rods, as well as all associated occupant relocation costs in a not to exceed amount of \$750,000.
- 3. Execution of these projects using the JOC contract is in the best interest of Lake County.
