- Determination of Cause and Manner of Death
 - Covers entire county
 - Scene investigations, forensic examination and toxicology
- Administrative Functions
 - Certification of death on Coroner Cases
 - Cremation permits for any death that occurs in Lake County
 - Case file management and record keeping
- Family Support
 - Assist family member throughout process
 - Provide medicolegal answers to survivors





 - Toxicologist












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- Departmental Statistics 2020
 - 6,143 Total Deaths Reported
 - 704 required further investigation
 - 579 required further examination
- Average Coroner Case 88/yr/Deputy
- Average Medical Case 682/yr/Deputy
- 2019 Comparison
 - 5,097 Total Deaths Reported
 - 513 required further investigation
 - 396 required further examination

 - Re-evaluate Mass Fatality Management plan
 - Discontinue rental of overflow storage site
 - Explore options that are cost effective
 - Expand and solidify partnerships



Previous 4 Months



- Staff Training and Evaluation
 - Explore training programs in line with County Goals
 - Begin implementation of evaluation process
 - Establish goals for employees based on County Initiatives
 - Improve office accountability and transparency



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Next 12 Months



- Community Involvement
 - Identify and collaborate with additional partner organizations
 - Provide increased services and resources for grieving families
 - Provide additional data to drive resources where needed

- Evaluate expenditures/contracts
 - Ensure Coroner contract services are fiscally responsible
 - Explore potential revenue generating lab services
 - Research grant funding for future equipment

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Next 12 Months



- Continue staff development and accountability
 - Achieve 100% of staff Crisis Intervention Team trained
 - Maintain staff accreditation through American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigators
 - Restructure managerial case review process
 - Fully implement Lake County evaluation process
 - Increase 60-day case closure rate to minimum 80%
