RE: IEMA Grant Agreement for the FEMA D-4461-IL Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)

for the Lake County All-Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan (ANHMP) Update in 2022

Action: Intergovernmental Grant Agreement Approval (SMC) Emergency Appropriation Approval (PWPT, F&A)

Stormwater Management Commission (SMC) received an intergovernmental grant agreement from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program through the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA). Emergency appropriations are needed for the project cost of \$67,500 which is not included in the current year budget. SMC will administer the grant project and staff time expended for grant management will be reimbursed.

- This grant agreement No. FEMA-4461-02P-DR-IL with the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA) provides funding for the 5-year update of the Lake County All-Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan through the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP).
- The grant amount is \$90,000; of which \$67,500 represents the 75% federal cost share, and \$22,500 represents the 25% local cost share which will be provided by SMC as in-kind services.
- The plan will be developed through a cooperative effort between SMC, Lake County Emergency Management Agency, and 52 municipalities.
