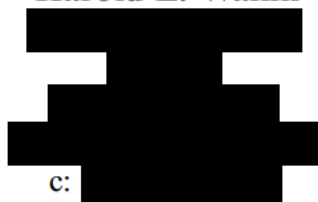


Harold L. Wallin
