- LCP responded to one new multi-state Request For Information in July, a \$50 million food processing facility project which would create 300 jobs.
- LCP has also been informed that Lake County locations have been shortlisted for three projects submitted by LCP, earlier in 2012. These three projects would have a total impact of \$94 million in investment and 171 jobs.

Motorola Mobility:

LCP has worked extensively with the Village of Libertyville in their efforts to retain Motorola Mobility at their Route 45 campus. LCP now focuses its efforts to work with the State of Illinois and local governments to address the company's move, and act to reverse the negative economic impact the vacancy will have on the Lake County economy.

LAKE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY SURVEY:

- LCP, as part of the ongoing Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) project has created 2 versions of a Lake County stakeholder survey, one for the Lake County business community, and one for LCP's government partners.
- The surveys, hosted on the Lake County Partners web site, will add current stakeholder insights to the data gathered by LCP and the project consultant, through Strategy Committee input, research, focus groups and individual stakeholder interviews.
- LCP has sent survey participation invitations and links by email, to much of the Lake County business and government community and welcomes all Lake County business and government participation in the survey.
- We believe that this survey will help in the creation of a strategy, which will help maintain Lake County's status, in future years, as a great business location.
