# HEALTH DEPARTMENT

## 7.1 <u>15-0490</u>

Joint resolution authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$123,256 in fiscal year (FY) 2015 budget as a result of grant increases delivered by Primary Care and Population Health Service Areas.

Jerry Nordstrom of Lake County Health Department presented a request for an emergency appropriation for various grant increases in the primary care and population health service areas.

A motion was made by Member Mandel, seconded by Member Weber, that this item be approved and referred on to Financial and Administrative Committee. The motion carried by the following vote:

# 7.2 <u>15-0493</u>

Ordinance amending Chapter 177: Lake County Tobacco Ordinance, of the Lake County Code.

Mark Pfister of the Health Department presented a request to amend the County's Tobacco Ordinance regulating the unincorporated areas of Lake County. The amendment would provide the Sheriff's Department the option to enforce via administrative adjudication or via the circuit court.

A motion made by Member Ross Cunningham, seconded by Member Hart.

Member Mandel questioned the need for administrative adjudication. Mr. Pfister indicated while a violation can be brought through the Circuit Court and result in a fine of \$250 to \$500, the process is lengthy and tedious. The administrative adjudication process sets the minimum fine of \$115, but depending on the severity of the situation and the number of previous violations, the fine can be increased beyond \$500.

Member Mandel noted the need to set standards in determining when violations go through the Circuit Court process or the administrative adjudication process. Discussion ensued. Lake County Board Chairman Lawlor expressed confidence in the administrative adjudication officer's decisions.

A motion was made by Member Mandel, seconded by Member Calabresa, to postpone consideration of this item. Member Mandel and Member Calabresa withdrew their motions to postpone to allow further discussion of this item.

Member Hart expressed support of the administrative adjudication process, indicating the process is as effective as the Circuit Court but saves the County time and money. Discussion continued.

A motion was made by Member Mandel, seconded by Member Calabresa, to postpone consideration of this item until the next Committee meeting. The motion failed by the following vote:
