Jodi Gingiss, Community Development Administrator, updated the HCDC on the failed Busy Brains Children's Museum project, for which Lake County holds a lien for repayment of CDBG expended funds. She said that the property is under contract and the funds will be repaid. She then informed the Commission about the status of the Lakeview Pointe Affordable Housing project, as the need for ethylene oxide testing has delayed the completion of the environment review. Staff is working directly with HUD on this project's environment review. Depending upon the length of time needed, the HCDC might have to make decisions on pending projects, due to HUD's spending ratio requirements. Staff will update the HCDC on the status of the projects during the June 12th meeting.
