Update and discussion on the State of Illinois 2020 Legislative Sessions.

Mike Grady and Derek Blaida, Strategic Advocacy Group, presented an update on the State of Illinois 2020 Legislative Sessions. Mr. Grady informed the committee that the Fall Veto Session is scheduled to begin the third week in November.

Mr. Blaida discussed revenue numbers and stated that after looking at January's revenue Illinois will be running about \$200 million behind historical projections. Discussion ensued.
