Ordinance amendment to remove the language from 111.040 Regulations Applicable to All Licensees (M) in the Lake County Liquor Commission Ordinance.

- On August 13, 2013, Lake County passed an ordinance allowing video gaming in unincorporated areas of Lake County and established requirements for video gaming licensing.
- The Liquor Commission recommends removing the language “Establishments with a state video gaming license must either generate at least 60% of gross annual income from food and beverage sales or have no more than 10% of its space dedicated to video gaming”.

### ORDINANCE

**WHEREAS,** On August 13, 2013, Lake County passed an ordinance allowing video gaming in unincorporated areas of Lake County and established requirements for video gaming licensing; and

**WHEREAS,** The Liquor Commission recommends removing the language “Establishments with a state video gaming license must either generate at least 60% of gross annual income from food and beverage sales or have no more than 10% of its space dedicated to video gaming”.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the amendment to the Lake County Liquor Control Ordinance be adopted and be made

effective immediately.
