Joint committee action approving change orders No. 1 and No. 2 to the contract with Tecorp, Inc. for the FY 2011 Facilities Painting Project.

- Change orders that exceed $10 \%$ of the original contract amount must be reviewed and approved by the Public Works and Transportation and Finance and Administrative Committees.
- The change orders are associated with contract changes for the FY2011 Facilities Painting Project.
- Change order No. 1 is for additional construction services that include the installation of polyurethane grout to eliminate floor and wall cracks that were discovered at the Brookside and Route 120 reservoirs.
- Change order No. 1 is for $\$ 14,040$ and increases the contract to $\$ 156,373$.
- Change order No. 2 is for critical rehabilitation after inspection of the Fox Lake Hills iron removal facility tank revealed excessive corrosion to the aerator assembly.
- Change order No. 2 is for $\$ 15,936.54$ and increases the total contract to $\$ 172,309.54$.
- These change orders increase the amount of the construction contract by $\$ 29,976.54$, or $21 \%$, from $\$ 142,333.00$ to $\$ 172,309.54$.
