- Onyx Waste Services is now known as Veolia Environmental Services, Waukegan, Illinois.
- There is a need to extend the current agreement with Veolia Environmental Services through February 28, 2011 in order to continue service and provide time to secure a new contract.
- This change is germane to the original contract as signed and is in the best interests of the County.
- Currently the contract cost approximately \$79,000 per year.
