Joint resolution authorizing a contract for the reconstruction and widening of Delany Road from Sunset Avenue to York House Road to Curran Contracting Company, Crystal Lake, Illinois, in the amount of \$10,056,082.94 and designated as Section 00-00093-17-WR.

- A total of 3 bids were received and the lowest responsible bidder is Curran Contracting Company, Crystal Lake, Illinois, with a contract amount of \$10,056,082.94.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to authority granted by this Lake County Board, the County Engineer heretofore called for sealed bids, by publication, to provide for the reconstruction, widening, installation of permanent traffic control signals and the construction of detention and compensatory flood plain areas on Delany Road, from Sunset Avenue to York House Road and designated as Section 00-00093-17-WR; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said publication and calling for said bids, sealed bids were received and opened on June 28, 2011, at 10:00 AM at the Lake County Division of Transportation in Libertyville, Illinois; a tabulation of said bids being as follows:

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Transportation Committee, the County Engineer and the Purchasing Agent have examined each bid, and it appears that the lowest responsible bidder is Curran Contracting Company, Crystal Lake, Illinois, in the amount of \$10,056,082.94, based on estimated quantities and unit prices; and

WHEREAS, this Lake County Board, by prior resolution at its meeting of May 10, 2011, appropriated \$4,025,000 of County Bridge Tax Funds, \$2,795,000 of Matching Tax funds and \$10,505,000 of ¼% for Transportation and Public Safety Tax funds for the improvement of the aforesaid section.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by this Lake County Board that a contract be awarded to said Curran Contracting Company, Crystal Lake, Illinois, in the amount of \$10,056,082.94, based on estimated quantities and unit prices and that the Purchasing Agent, the County Clerk, and the County Engineer of Lake County be authorized and they are hereby directed to enter into a contract with said low bidder to provide for the reconstruction and widening of Delaney Road from Sunset Avenue to York House Road and designated as Section 00-00093-17-WR.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in as much as such estimated quantities are the best approximation that can be determined at this time, these quantities may be added to, deducted from, or modified from in the final determination of the contract cost in accordance with Chapter 605 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, Act 5, Section 5-205.2 without further Board action, providing the final cost chargeable to the funds appropriated does not exceed the appropriation.
